

Mystery Quilt - Saturday, September 16, 2017
Approximate finished size: 48" x 63"

For this project you will need 3 fabrics ranging from light to dark. (I used a yellow, medium green and medium-dark blue.) If you choose other colors, that's fine, but please mark your colors on the instructions so that you know what fabric you purchased for what area.

You can use fabrics with very small prints or fabrics that appear solid from a distance.

Materials:

5/8 yard yellow

1¼ yards medium green

1 yard blue

1-7/8 yards white on white (or off white, or solid black or any other solid color that appears in high contrast with the other fabrics you've chosen)

3¼ yards backing fabric

56" x 71" rectangle of quilt batting

Prior to class, please complete the following

Cutting:

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Border strips are the exact length needed. You may want to make them longer to allow for piecing variations.

From Yellow fabric, cut:

- 13 (1½" wide) strips. Set aside 5 strips for borders.

From Medium Green fabric, cut:

- 16 (1½" wide) strips. Set aside 5 strips for borders.

From Blue fabric, cut:

- 20 (1½" wide) strips. Set aside 5 strips for borders.

From White fabric (or background fabric), cut:

- 15 (3½" wide) strips.
- From 5 strips, cut 58 (3½") squares.
- 5 (1½" wide) strips for strip sets.
