Supply Sheet

1/2 yard cut of SIX different colors of SHADED fabric will yield 12 Wave blocks 18" x 18" (total of 3 yards)

Other Fabric Options:

1/2 yard cut of SIX different fabrics will yield 12 Wave blocks 18" x 18" (total of 3 yards)
OR

1 1/2 yard cut of TWO different fabrics will yield 12 Wave blocks 18" x 18" (total of 3 yards)

Shaded Gray Fabric - 1 2/3 yards
(used for row division strips & outer borders)

BLACK fabric - 2 1/2 yards
(used for curved block divisions, bordering of division strips, inner side borders & binding)

Backing Fabric - 4 1/2 yards

3/8" Bias Bar
(metal or nylon)
or any method preferred to
make 3/8" wide bias strips
